

PARENTS PLEDGE OF ACCEPTANCE

FINANCES

We, as parents who have accepted our God-given responsibility to **“train up our child in the way he should go,”** pledge our trust in Riverview Baptist Christian School to be an extension of our training.

We pledge that our home will provide a secure haven of safety and be consistent with our church and school teaching.

We pledge our **loyal support** to the Pastors, teachers and staff as we make **RBCS** our glad-hearted choice for the years our children are enrolled.

We pledge that, if for any reason our child does not respond favorably to the school, we will not try to change the school to fit his needs, but will withdraw him quietly and without delay.

We pledge to have our children to school on time each day. If a parent brings a student to school late, the parent must personally check the student in with the office or teacher.

ACCREDITATION

I understand that RBCS is operated as a ministry of Riverview Baptist Church and is not recognized by the state of Washington. I accept full responsibility for placing my children in this school (as explained to me) realizing that public schools may not accept credits given by RBCS.

DISCIPLINE

We hereby invest authority in the school to discipline our child as necessary. We further agree that we will cooperate and discipline our child in the home as needed. (Prov. 13:24; 19:18; 22:6; 23:13-14; 29:15, 17; Col. 3:20; Heb. 12:6)

Corporal punishment will be administered under the following guidelines:

1. The offense will be clearly discussed with your child.

2. A staff member will discuss Spiritual applications and will pray with your child.

3. A reasonable number of firm strokes, not to exceed 5, will be administered by the principal or teacher using a simple, flat paddle.

4. A staff witness of the same sex as your child will be present.

5. Your child will not be physically restrained. (If he or she refuses to submit to paddling, you will be asked to come to discuss the matter; and if it is believed to be in the best interest of the school, the child will be withdrawn from the church-school.)

6. After administering of the strokes, the staff member will pray with your child, assuring him or her of their love.

7. A written report will be made of the date, offense, number of strokes, and name of correcting staff member and witness. A copy will be sent to you.
